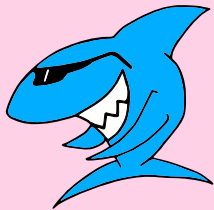

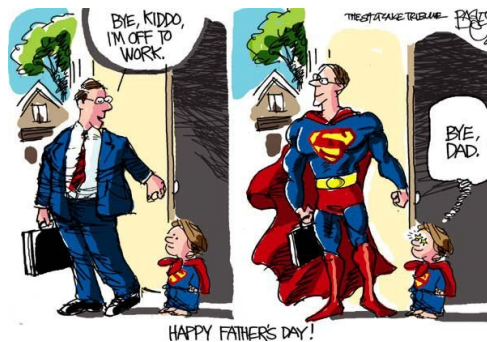

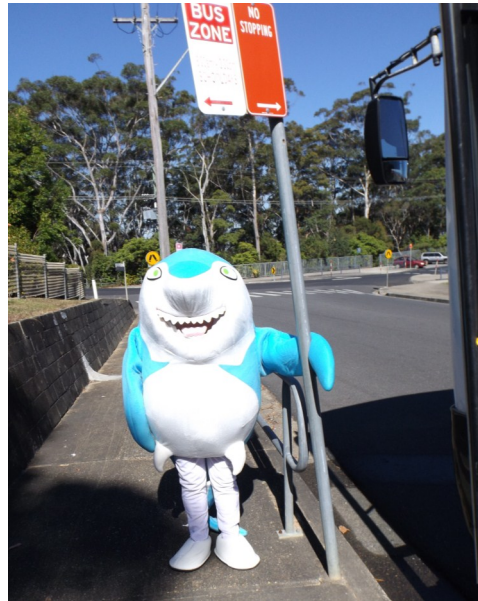
UNSW

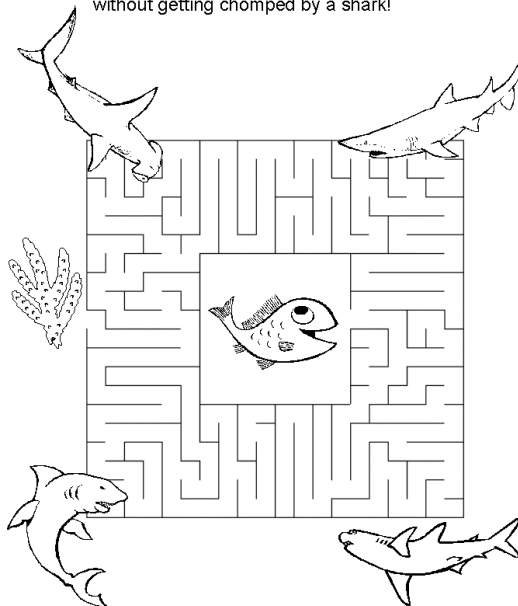
is responsible for our magnificent gardens and grounds as well as providing extra reading support for some lucky students.
