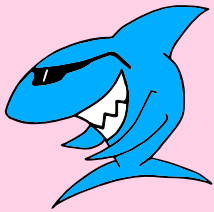

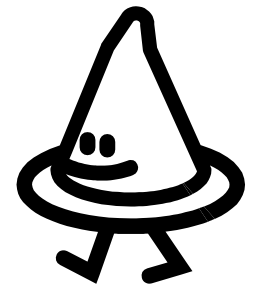


Importance of attendance

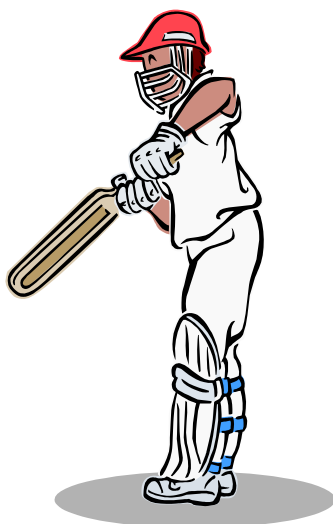

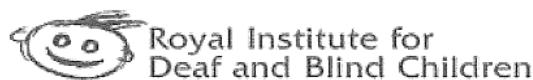


Hello Nambucca
